



OUR COURSES

DESCRIPTION OF LEVELS

A1 / A2

At this level, classes will be conducted in Spanish from the first class. Students can introduce themselves and others and ask and answer questions about personal details such as where they live, people they know, and things they have.

Students will be able to read, write, and speak in simple texts, paragraphs, etc. And can communicate in simple and routine tasks requiring a simple and direct exchange of information on familiar and routine matters.

B1 / B2

At this level, students will improve their speaking, writing, reading, and listening abilities. Can produce simple connected text on familiar topics or of personal interest.

Students can describe experiences and events, dreams, hopes, and ambitions, and briefly give reasons and explanations for opinions and plans. They can understand the main points of clear standard input on familiar matters regularly encountered in work, school, leisure, etc.

Students can produce clear, detailed text on a wide range of subjects and explain a viewpoint on a topical issue, giving the advantages and disadvantages of various options. Also, they can interact with a degree of fluency and spontaneity that makes regular interaction with native speakers quite possible without strain for either party.

C1 / C2

At this level, students can understand a wide range of demanding, longer clauses and recognize implicit meaning. Can express ideas fluently and spontaneously without much obvious searching for expressions.

Students can use language flexibly and effectively for social, academic, and professional purposes. They can produce clear, well-structured, detailed text on complex subjects, showing controlled use of organizational patterns, connectors, and cohesive devices.

Students can understand with ease virtually everything they hear or read. Can summarize information from different spoken and written sources, reconstructing arguments and accounts in a coherent presentation. They can express themselves spontaneously, fluently, and precisely, differentiating finer shades of meaning even in the most complex situations.

DESCRIPTION OF COURSES

COURSES FOR CHILDREN AND YOUNG LEARNERS

Instituto Aleixandre offers Spanish Courses for Children and Teenagers specially designed for them. These are some characteristics:

1. **Courses** are designed for students **ages 8 to 14**.
2. The **methodology** used has been adapted to suit the special needs of students, with an emphasis on the playful aspect of learning: songs, games, and fun activities are commonly used in class.
3. The **syllabus** is based on textbooks and (CEFR), specially designed for children, following their learning rhythm.
4. A Special application to connect teachers with students & parents and to provide a wide variety of extra materials and games.

Children's Course Structure:

A1 and A2 levels are divided into sub-levels as follows:

A1: A1.1 + A1.2 + A1.3

A2: A2.1 + A2.2 + A2.3

School Course

REGISTRATION AND PAYMENTS

Registration Hours: Monday to Saturday 10:00 a.m. to 06:00 p.m. / 10:00 to 18:00 (IST).

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

1. Choose a type of Spanish course: Regular, Special, Children's, or School.
2. In the registration, students must mention the details of the course.
3. For registration in the Spanish course, students must have to fill out the registration form and send it to us through the mail or WhatsApp. This form is also available on our website www.institutoaleixandre.com, and it can be obtained through WhatsApp.
4. After providing the basic details, pay the course fee.
5. Received the registration receipt by mail or WhatsApp & hurray! Registration is complete.

- Registration can also be made through **WhatsApp** on Instituto Aleixandre's official phone number [8585995993](tel:8585995993).
- Registrations are on a **first-come-first-serve basis**.
- The minimum age for registration in a **Regular** and **Special** Spanish course is **+14 years**.
- The age for registration in a **Children's Course** is **8 to 14 years**.
- We cannot guarantee that students and their previous classmates will be placed into the same batch if there are parallel batches of the same time of a level.
- Reservations are not accepted.

PAYMENT METHODS

- Payments can be made through Bank transfer, UPI [Paytm, Google Pay, PhonePe, BHIM, MobiKwik], etc. Debit Card, Credit Card, and Cash.
- Registration will only be made to those students who have **fully paid** the course **fees**.
- Payment details will be provided at the time of registration.
- In the transaction, please write the name of the student in the remarks or wherever possible

SPANISH EXAMS AND LEVEL TEST

SPANISH EXAMS

The dates of the Spanish exam are fixed. A student who cannot appear in the exam on the fixed date due to any reason may:

1. Send an email to jmd@institutoaleixandre.com / Institutoaleixandre1@gmail.com, attaching the document or with a reason to justify the absence.
2. Once the reason is approved, the student can apply for a new date on the payment of RS 500 (INR) through our payment method.
3. After payment, the exam will be rescheduled within 7 to 15 days.

LEVEL TEST

A level test is required for the following cases:

1. Returning students of Instituto Aleixandre after 6 months for A1, A2, and B1 levels.
2. Students who have studied Spanish in the past, and have never studied at Instituto Aleixandre.
3. A student who had studied before at Aleixandre but had not registered in any Spanish course in the past 6 months for A1, A2, and B1 levels.

Students must fill out the **Level Test Form**, which is available on our website, and send it to us through the mail or WhatsApp.

The results of the level test are final. And there is no means of a certificate for the level test. The validity of the level test result is 6 months for A1, A2, and B1 levels.

The cost of the level test is RS 500 (INR). This amount is to be paid at least five days before the date of the level test or in advance, and it will be deducted from the total course fees upon enrolment. The period for the deduction of this amount is 6 months, and is counted from the day the payment is made.

For students who do not present for the level test, their amount will not be refunded. **For level tests, contact the registration department.**

CERTIFICATE AND REFUNDS

COURSE MATERIAL

Teachers will give students digital course materials related to their course.

CERTIFICATE

- The course certificate will be provided once a student has completed a course.
- This type of certificate is issued upon the request of the student.
- Please allow 7 working days for certificate processing.
- Course certificate has lifetime validity.

REFUND

- Students will be allotted to another batch, or fees will be fully refundable if Instituto Aleixandre cancels a course due to an internal reason.
- All refunds will be processed before the end of each academic year.
 1. January 2026 to December 2026 refunds must be settled by December 31, 2026.
- Once the course has begun, the registration fees will not be refunded, also refunds will not be granted for unattended classes by students.
- Refunds will only be given upon presentation of the payment receipt and a valid ID with a photo.
- Refunds will not be given to students who left the course prematurely, regardless of any circumstances.

REGULATIONS

STUDENT DETAILS

- Students are responsible for updating their details, and this should be rectified in the administration.
- Students' details are private and confidential. Request for such details will not be addressed.

CLASS SIZE

- The maximum number of students allowed in every batch is 15.
- The Regular Course started with a minimum of 3 to 5 students.
- A special Course has been started for a smaller number of students.
- Inquiring about the number of registered students in a class will not be addressed, as this is internal administrative information.

FACULTY

- Instituto Aleixandre will not provide any information related to a course's assigned professor in advance.
- Instituto Aleixandre reserves the right to change the professors after a course has started.
- Professors will be assigned to their classes after the last date of registration.
- The desired professor can be allocated if a group of students (minimum 7) sends a joint email to get registered in the same batch.
- Instituto Aleixandre has both native and non-native teachers. Allotment of a teacher is based on the availability of the teacher. The institute monitors all its teachers from time to time.

RULES

- Choosing a class or timing option is difficult to change, but possibilities can only be made before the last date of registration.
- Once a course has started, student requests for a change in batch, date, and time will not be accepted. After registration, students should check their details in the registration receipt to make sure they are in the correct batch, date, and time.
- Before the first class, students will receive an email from their assigned teachers to join the Google Classroom, where they will get links to attend their classes.
- It is not possible to attend a missed class by taking a session in a different batch or group.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. How could I learn Spanish if I do not know much English?

People often think about how they could learn Spanish if they do not know much English or if their English-speaking skills are not good. Learning Spanish requires just basic English; if you can read and understand this question and answer, then you know enough English to learn Spanish.

2. What is the registration Procedure in the Instituto Aleixandre?

The registration procedure at the Instituto Aleixandre is very simple.

The Instituto Aleixandre offers two types of courses for adults and a course for children and teenagers to adapt to students' needs, interests, and availability.

1. Choose the type of Spanish course: Regular or Special course.
2. Choose the level, start date, end date & timings of the course.
3. Fill in the Registration Form on the registration and payments page or send us the registration form through the mail or WhatsApp.
4. After providing the basic details, pay the course fee (Payment details will be provided at the time of registration).
5. Received the registration receipt by mail or WhatsApp.
6. Hooray! Registration complete.

3. How is our syllabus?

The syllabus of Instituto Aleixandre is based on two categories:

The Instituto Aleixandre syllabus is designed according to the students.

The Common European Framework of Reference for Languages ([CEFR](#)) was established by the European Council to ensure uniformity and transparency in language throughout the world.

4. What could we become after learning Spanish?

Learning a new language opens many doors to the future and sets up a new world. After learning Spanish, students can do various things like these, but not limited to as students can become a Spanish translator, interpreter, professor, teacher, guide, or work at an embassy, call center, etc.

5. How are our teachers?

All our teachers/professors, whether native or non-native speakers, have university degrees and teaching experience to teach Spanish as a foreign language. Our teachers are either natives of Spanish-speaking countries or are DELE-certified. This point plays an important role, as a student understands the culture and learns various things about Spain and Spanish-speaking countries.

For any reason, if any of our teachers is not teaching, then students can make a complaint to the Head of Studies. We will take serious action against the same.

6. What type of courses do we offer?

REGULAR COURSE: 48 Hours, 24 Days – 24 Classes (2 hours per class)

3 / 4 / 5 / 6 Days a week. Mon to Sat

SPECIAL COURSE: 48 HOURS, 32 DAYS – 32 CLASSES (1.5 HOURS PER CLASS)

4 / 5 / 6 Days a week. Mon to Sat

Children Course

SEVEN WEEK COURSE: 30 Hours, 20 Classes (1.5 hours per class).

3 days a week (Mon to Sat).

For timings and schedules, contact the registration department.

School Course

School course: In this course, the school syllabus will be covered. 2 classes a week. Max 8 classes in a month. 1 hour per class. For timings and schedules, contact the registration department.

7. How do I know what my Spanish proficiency level is?

People with some knowledge of Spanish who have never studied Spanish at the Instituto Aleixandre, or the students who have not attended any course in the last 6 months or more, must take a level test before registering for our Spanish language courses.

Typically, the level test consists of an oral section and, in some cases, a written section. It lasts approximately 30 minutes and costs RS 500 (INR), the sum of which is deductible from the enrolment fee.

8. Can I switch to a different group, course, or level?

Group changes are not allowed. Also, it is not possible to attend a missed class by taking a class in a different batch or group. A change of course or level is only allowed if it is proven that the student is not enrolled in the correct course or level. In this case, the opinion of the professor is necessary.

The consultation and approval of the Head of Studies will be necessary for any change.

9. Will I have the same professor for all courses?

No. A professor may teach a maximum of 3 to 4 consecutive courses to the same group of students. We believe that studying with different professors benefits students and teachers because every teacher has a different way of teaching and interacting with students.

10. Can I choose my professor?

Yes, students can choose their professors if most students from a batch want the same professor. They must send a joint email to the institute for the same. In the end, it depends on the availability of that professor. Therefore, all our professors are specially trained to teach Spanish as a foreign language.

11. How are students evaluated?

Our courses may involve two types of assessments: a series of evaluation assignments carried out throughout the course or a final exam.

Whether evaluation assignments or a final exam, the student will obtain a final grade based on his/her participation, attendance, evaluation assignments, and final exam, according to the following table:

- 9-10 Outstanding
- 7-8 Best
- 5-6 Pass
- Less than 5 Fail

What are evaluation assignments?

Evaluation assignments are activities that students perform throughout the course, whose marks will be added to the final result.

Final Exams

- To move on to a higher level or pass a level, passing the exam with a minimum grade 50% is necessary for A1, A2, and B1 levels.

- If a student did not attain the minimum grade established for passing a level or moving on to a higher level, then he/she must have to repeat the course.
- If a student fails a level 2 consecutive times, his/her level will not be dropped, and he/she can repeat a level an infinite number of times.

12. What about course material and final grades?

Once the course has started, students will get everything from the meeting link, class notes, documents, and books in the Google Classroom application.

Students will get an email to join the Google Classroom application before the first class of every course. At the end of the course, students will get their evaluation/final results from their teachers in class and in the application.

13. What about result rechecks and complaints?

If a student disagrees with his/her evaluation or final grade, he/she has the right to complain or request a reevaluation. The procedure that follows will vary according to the method used:

- If the student has been graded through evaluation assignments, these must be corrected by the professor in front of the student, so that he/she can be aware of his/her mistakes and results.

If a student is still disagreeing with his/her grades/results, the Head of Studies will analyze the case and take the necessary measures.

14. What about course certificates?

- The course certificate will be provided once a student has completed a course.
- This type of certificate is issued upon the request of the student.
- Please allow 7 working days for certificate processing.
- Course certificate has lifetime validity.

15. What can I do? If I am not comfortable in the class.

All the students and teachers of the Instituto Aleixandre have full right to register a complaint by writing an email to the Head of Studies, if a student or a teacher behaves improperly in the class, with a particular student, or with the whole class. Or targeting a specific group, caste, religion, community, etc. Saying unacceptable comments, using bad words in a class, or doing the wrong thing.

The mental and physical health & safety of our students and teachers are important to us. The information of the person who makes the complaint will remain confidential. And the Head of Studies will take serious action against the complaint.
